The following documentation provides information that can be used when delivering products/features to the market.

Information is designed to highlight business value, showcase possible applications, and provide additional product knowledge:

Competency based access

The Competency feature provides the ability to track what certification/qualification a cardholder has, and then either allow or deny access based on the detail. Cardholders can have more than one competency, providing further ability to tailor zone access to only allow people in that should be there.

Business benefits

Competencies allow our customers to ensure that they people in zones have the necessary qualifications to be there. This allows them to:

- Provide proof that only qualified people are where they should be, helping to protect them liability in the event of an incident
- Ensure business continuity, the assurance that they won't have unqualified cardholders causing production shut downs.

Competencies can be set to automatically expire at the same time as the person's qualifications expire, thus disabling their access. Additionally, both the cardholder and their supervisor can be notified via SMS and/or email in advance of the certificate's expiry. This allows the site to organize for a recertification in advance of the expiry date, insuring against a surprise shut down due to pulling an employee out of work during a shift.

Examples of competencies are:

- Site Inductions
- First Aide Certificates
- Vehicle Licenses
- Alcohol Tests
- Drug Tests
